

‘Phonics and Talk Time’ Alphabet Letter Tiles: 1) Match capital and lower case letter shapes. 2) Make words from tiles for child to sound out and blend (*print-to-sound* is decoding). 3) Say words consisting of simple spellings to identify the sounds all-through-the-word and then allot the letters to spell the words (*sound-to-print* is encoding). Make simple sentences using ‘The’ and the full stop ‘.’.
